THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS (SI 2004 1633)

The Environment Agency gives notice that the Poole and Christchurch Bays Shoreline Management Plan (SMP) was adopted on 1st July 2011. It is available for inspection alongside its Environmental Report and a Statement of Environmental Particulars (in line with Regulation 16(4)) at the locations set out below.

The Poole and Christchurch Bays SMP provides a large scale assessment of the risks associated with coastal evolution and presents a policy framework to address these risks in a sustainable manner with respect to people and to the developed, historic and natural environment. The SMP covers 190km of coastline from Hurst Spit in the east to Durlston Head in the west, including the coastal communities of Swanage, Studland, Poole, Bournemouth, Christchurch, Highcliffe, Barton-on-Sea and Milford-on-Sea
